



## BREEDER FEATURE CYNTHIA HUCKINS

### **Introduce yourself and your family**

For those of you that don't know me, I am Cynthia Huckins, owner/operator of Ruby Mtn Sheep Co. My husband, Gary and I live in Spring Creek, NV at the bases of the beautiful Ruby Mountains. Together we have one daughter, four sons, five grandsons and one granddaughter. My granddaughter, Jilly is part of the hands-on daily operation and grandson Deizl helps during the summer months.

### **Give us a brief description of your Suffolk flock**

Our flock of registered Suffolk sheep consist of between 20-30 ewes. Our goal has always been to raise structurally correct, big, beautiful Suffolks that work well for us and the breeders we sell to.

### **Why did you choose to raise Suffolks?**

As a little kid I thought Suffolks were the most beautiful sheep with their slick black head and legs and the white wool bodies. There is something magical every time I see them running in pasture with their long floppy ears, in a lambing barn with babies or standing in a show ring looking flawless. Plus they are big! I cannot lie, I LOVE big sheep!

### **What advice do you have for people starting out with Suffolks?**

My advice to people that want to raise Suffolks is, choose the type and kind you want to raise. Success will not happen overnight, but using a great stud buck will help you move your flock in the right direction. There will always be set backs and disappointments along the way, but having a passion and true love for the breed will get you through those times.

### **What are one or two things that you have found to be critical needs for the success of your Suffolk flock?**

A few things that I have found helpful in building the flock I have are, like I said earlier, always breed with the best stud bucks to make the future of your flock. Secondly, build on what works and don't be afraid to cull sheep that are not making better sheep than themselves.

### **Who are some people that you credit for your success with Suffolks?**

I was very fortunate to have Kurt Birky as a friend and mentor. His insight and knowledge of the Suffolk breed has been instrumental in the development of our flock and success.

### **Final four quick questions, just for fun What is your favorite sports team?**

I really don't get into sports, but Gary and I enjoy going to Fort Worth in the fall for the NRCHA Snaffle Bit Futurity and Las Vegas in December to watch the NFR.

### **What is your favorite food?**

Most of you that know me, know that I am a foodie. In my book there isn't much that can beat a great salad and steak!

### **What is the top item on your bucket list?**

As for a bucket list, I enjoy the life I have. Making memories with my family and the people I enjoy, means the most to me.

### **What is your favorite place you have visited?**

# OPTIMIZING EWE HEALTH AND PRODUCTIVITY IN LATE GESTATION

Proper management of ewes during late pregnancy (the final 6-8 weeks of gestation) is critical for successful lambing outcomes. This period represents the most important phase for fetal development, with approximately two-thirds of the lamb's birth weight gained during the last six weeks of gestation. Strategic management during this time directly impacts lamb survival, birth weights, colostrum production, and subsequent milk production.

## Nutrition

Energy becomes the most critical nutritional factor during late pregnancy. For a 175-pound mature ewe, Total Digestible Nutrients (TDN) requirements increase from 55% during early gestation to 57–66% during late gestation. The energy requirement becomes particularly critical during the final two weeks before lambing. Twin-bearing ewes require 16% more total energy than single-bearing ewes, and triplet-bearing ewes require 31% more total energy than single-bearing ewes. Crude protein requirements increase to approximately 11% during late pregnancy, compared to 9.4% during early gestation. Multiple-bearing ewes have significantly higher protein demands, with twin-bearing ewes requiring a 23% increase in crude protein requirements. It is recommended to begin grain supplementation 3–6 weeks pre-lambing for multiple-birth ewes.

Mineral and vitamin requirements during gestation should not be an afterthought. Late-gestation ewes with inadequate calcium intake are prone to milk fever. Monitor calcium intake carefully, especially when feeding corn grain and hay diets, as grains are typically low in calcium and high in phosphorus. Selenium and vitamin E are critical during gestation and should be addressed specifically in selenium-deficient regions. These nutrients work together to improve reproductive performance, prevent white muscle disease in lambs, and enhance overall immune function.

## Body Condition

Body condition scoring uses a 5-point scale (1 = emaciated, 5 = obese). Proper assessment requires hands-on evaluation rather than visual inspection alone. The aim should be to have approximately 80% of your flock scoring between 2–4. Ewes with BCS below 2.5 at late gestation have an increased risk of pregnancy toxemia. It takes approximately six weeks to raise BCS by one point, emphasizing the need for early monitoring. Ewes with BCS of 3–4 at lambing wean heavier lambs and have better survival rates.

Ewes that are either over-conditioned or too thin are at risk of experiencing pregnancy toxemia (ketosis), which occurs when energy demands exceed intake during late pregnancy, causing ewes to mobilize body fat reserves. By assessing body condition score in mid- to late gestation, producers can sort groups based on their body condition or fetal count and manage those ewes appropriately. Ultrasound diagnosis of fetal count at around days 35–40 after the removal of rams will give a rough estimate for managing ewe nutrition.



## Health

Vaccination protocols are essential for protecting both ewes and newborn lambs during the critical period surrounding lambing. The most important vaccination for sheep is the CDT vaccine, which protects against *Clostridium perfringens* types C and D (overeating disease) and *Clostridium tetani* (tetanus). These clostridial diseases are often fatal and strike suddenly, making prevention through vaccination the most effective management strategy.

Previously vaccinated ewes should receive a single CDT booster vaccination 2–4 weeks prior to lambing. This timing ensures optimal antibody transfer through colostrum to provide passive immunity to newborn lambs. First-time mothers require two vaccinations during late pregnancy, administered 4–6 weeks apart, with the final dose given 3–4 weeks before lambing. Research confirms that vaccinating ewes 3–4 weeks prior to lambing produces the highest antibody response and most effective protection for nursing lambs.

The vaccination of pregnant ewes is particularly critical because lambs cannot effectively respond to direct vaccination until they are 6–8 weeks of age due to their immature immune systems. Maternal antibodies received through colostrum provide protection for approximately 6–10 weeks, after which lambs should receive their own primary vaccination series. Studies have shown that vaccinating lambs before 6 weeks of age is ineffective, making maternal vaccination the only reliable early-life protection method.

Internal parasite control is also important, as immediately before and around the time of lambing, there is a notable rise in fecal egg counts known as the periparturient rise, which can compromise maternal health and milk production. This phenomenon occurs approximately two weeks before lambing and can persist for up to eight weeks after parturition, with fecal egg counts typically peaking around 28 days postpartum. Strategic anthelmintic treatment may be warranted based on fecal egg count monitoring or targeted selective treatments like FAMACHA scoring to identify ewes in need of treatment prior to the breeding or lambing season. The FAMACHA system identifies animals with anemia caused by barber pole worm by scoring conjunctival color from 1–5, with pregnant and lactating ewes scoring 3 or higher typically recommended for treatment. However, some dewormers have abortifacient effects and should be avoided during pregnancy. Benzimidazole dewormers such as Valbazen (albendazole) are teratogenic and should not be used during the first 30 days of pregnancy, as research shows these compounds can cause congenital malformations in up to 60% of sheep embryos when administered during early gestation.

## Conclusion

Successful late pregnancy management in sheep requires a comprehensive approach integrating proper nutrition, body condition management, and health protocols. The investment in proper late pregnancy management pays dividends through improved lamb survival, better birth weights, enhanced colostrum production, and stronger overall flock performance. Producers should work with their veterinarians and extension specialists to develop management protocols tailored to their specific operation and regional conditions.
